

Announcement for the post of National consultant on health policy analysis, monitoring and evaluation

Objective

To ensure greater use of evidence and analysis for policy decisions, strategic planning and performance monitoring in the health sector of the Republic of Moldova

Description of duties

The incumbent will provide assistance to the Ministry of Health in order to strengthen its activity relating to sector monitoring, priority policy analysis and planning. The incumbent will provide specific assistance in producing reports and priority analysis of policies in the health sector and their efficiency, under the direction of the minister of health and delegated departments.

The specific activities of the incumbent will include:

1. Collecting, synthesising and reporting of data for monitoring reports regarding sectoral and intersectoral policies, as required by the Ministry of Health;
2. Contributing to the revision and updating of public policies, including the National Health Policy, the National Strategy for the Development of the Health Sector, the MTEF, the Governmental Programme of activities and other documents (adjusting with international documents and practices), as required by the Ministry of Health;
3. Providing support in the context of identifying long-term development priorities for the MoH in the process of developing its strategic development programme;
4. Contributing to the drafting of ministerial orders and other documents, as required
5. Providing methodological assistance to DAMEP and other departments within the Ministry of Health in developing, analysing, impact evaluating, and monitoring public policies;
6. Participating in the planning and implementing of studies for evidence generation in decision making, as required;
7. Contributing to the continuous development of the health sector performance monitoring framework, including the organization of workshops, collection of data on indicators according to the approved framework, providing analysis and drafting, if required;
8. Participating in the organization of annual review meetings on health sector performance, based on the performance framework and potential annual report;
9. Contributing to other activities relevant for the Ministry of Health and WHO Country Office according to ad hoc needs;
10. Providing effective liaison and regular updates to the WHO Country Office, and working closely with policy advisor/analyst and other WHO staff in the Country Office.

Advanced University degree in medicine or related areas and/or post-graduate degree in social sciences or public health

Minimum 3 years of national experience in the management of public health programmes/systems or international development

Experience of working with international organizations/institutions

Excellent knowledge of Romanian and English, working knowledge of Russian
